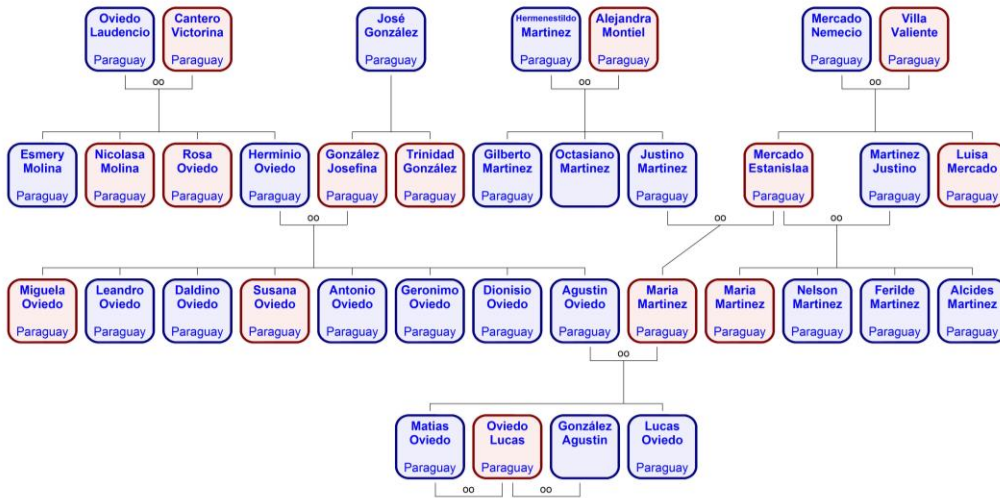


Matías Oviedo
